



Trinity Transport, Inc. (TTFD) – Safety Policy

Trinity Transport has a 24 hour Safety Program in place. We are contracted with Hazmat One, a nationwide emergency responder. In the event of a spill or accident, we utilize Hazmat One, when approved by the customer. Hazmat One analyzes the situation and reports back to Trinity immediately. Hazmat One handles the cleanup and proper disposal of the material and provides a full written report to Trinity Transport. This coverage is available 24 hours per day/ 7 days per week.

Trinity Transport works closely with our customers that ship hazardous materials. We follow their policy relative to the proper handling of any spills or accidents. Trinity maintains copies of the MSDS and abides by and follows the safety procedures set forth by our customers.

In the event of an accident or spill we immediately contact our customer. If they are a party to Chemtrec, we notify Chemtrec first. All carriers handling shipments for Trinity are pre-approved and have complete instructions to follow should an accident or incident occur. Trinity Transport follows the guidelines set down by our customers' Safety Department.

Trinity Transport employees that arrange shipments that are Chemical or Hazardous go through DOT/Hazmat Awareness Training. This training is in accordance with the requirements of DOT 49 CFR 100-185. This training is updated every three years as required by law. Trinity Transport has 24/7 coverage in the event of an accident or spill.

Trinity Transport only uses approved carriers who meet all of our Safety Requirements. We maintain a carrier compliance department whose only job is to certify that all carriers are approved and in compliance at all times. All carriers must sign a contract with Trinity, and submit current insurance certificates showing Trinity Transport as named insured. They must also submit a copy of their Hazmat Authority/License. We maintain and monitor the carriers' Safety Rating. This is done through the Safer System. Many of Trinity Transports carriers are members of Responsible Care®, NACD Affiliate Program as well as ISO certified.

Trinity Transport takes matters of “**SAFETY**” very seriously. We have open communications about the safe handling and transport of chemical and hazardous shipments. Trinity Transport has a Hazardous Procedures handbook that all employees use as a guideline to handle chemical and hazardous shipments.

Our Safety programs protect our customers, carriers, our company and employee's as well as our stakeholders.

Trinity Transport takes our business and operations seriously. At all levels we strive for continual improvement in Safety, Health, the Environment and Security.

As a statement of our commitment to the Safe Handling of Chemical and Hazardous Shipments, Trinity Transport has adopted and put in place best practices for the transport of all chemical and hazardous shipments.

Trinity Transport has been accepted into the American Chemistry Council's Responsible Care® partnership program and has adopted the American Chemistry Council's Responsible Care® Guiding Principles.

Trinity Transport's policy is always **“SAFETY FIRST”**.
